NOTES FROM MEETING WITH DALTON GIBBS
ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION PROGRAMMES

1. Day Programme:

- around Rondevlei

2. Zeekoevlei environmental education programme → 3 days:

- in-land system
- sandy beach ecology
- landfill site
- sewerage works

3. Issues:

- 'wilderness feel' would be compromised
- noise
- access
- light
- visual
- impact on overall experience

4. Mitigation:

- Instead of raising the road, a double dune system through the 'False Bay Ecology Park'
- Underpasses to accommodate children
- Overhead footbridge better for safe access
- Retaining wall on side of dune

5. Other:

- Proposal to put swift boxes under road not desirable as they currently don't exist in the area.
- Penway could sponsor environmental education trust; the cost would be R2.7 million. Penway could buy this trust. This would be 'in kind' mitigation.
- Zandvlei environmental education centre will be heavily impacted; a meeting should be held with Clifford Dorse who runs this education centre. (tel: 701 7542).
- Growing of indigenous plants for the berms should commence early on in the construction phase.
